NORTH CAROLINA ABC COMMISSION ISSUES SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF ABC PERMITS AT GREENSBORO BUSINESS

RALEIGH – The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission suspended the ABC permits for a Greensboro business, Tranquilo, on April 16. The suspension came as a result of a review of sworn statements submitted by law enforcement officers of the Greensboro Police Department (GPD), Special Agents of North Carolina Alcohol Law Enforcement (ALE), and Greensboro civilians.

Tranquilo, at 221 South Elm Street, Greensboro, has held ABC permits since June 2018.

The summary suspension is immediate and is in effect until the case is heard by the Office of Administrative Hearings. The action is authorized under N.C. General Statute <u>150B-3(c)</u>, which states: "The proceedings shall be promptly commenced and determined."

This is the second summary suspension issued this year by the NC ABC Commission.
