

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION

APPLICATION FOR COMMON AREA ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT

- Authorizes a customer of a multi-tenant establishment holding this permit to exit a licensed premises with an open
 container of an alcoholic beverage sold by a tenant holding the proper ABC permit(s). It allows the customer to
 consume the alcoholic beverage within the confines of any indoor or outdoor common area designated by the
 owner of the property, who holds this permit, for the consumption of alcoholic beverages. A Hotel or Multi-Tenant
 Establishment, as described below, may apply for the permit.
- HOTEL An establishment engaged in the business of furnishing lodging. The hotel has a restaurant either on the
 premises or a restaurant closely associated with the premises. The hotel and restaurant do not need to be owned by
 the same person/entity.
- MULTI-TENANT ESTABLISHMENT A building or structure, or multiple buildings or structures on the same property,
 or within the same planned development, under common ownership, control or property owners' association
 governance. It contains multiple businesses which sell food, goods, services or a combination thereof, and includes
 or is connected by common areas.
 - (A shopping mall is not a multi-tenant establishment if more than fifty percent (50%) of the shopping mall's common areas, measured in acreage or square footage, are enclosed and air-conditioned. However, any outdoor common area not used for parking and is associated with the shopping mall shall be deemed as appropriate for the Common Area Entertainment Permit.)

PERMIT CONDITIONS:

- 1. Owner or property owners' association of the multi-tenant establishment shall designate the common area in which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and post signs in conspicuous locations on the multi-tenant property identifying the designated common area. The owner or property owner's association must submit a plat or map to the ABC Commission for review and approval. The Commission will reject any plat or map which does not meet the following statutory requirements:
 - a. A plat of the multi-tenant establishment with the designated outdoor common area designated for alcohol consumption clearly marked; or,
 - b. A detailed map of the relevant building on the multi-tenant property for a designated indoor common area with the designated area for alcohol consumption clearly marked;
 - c. The owner or property owners' association of the multi-tenant establishment shall submit a plat or map as required for each renewal of the permit and at least ten (10) days prior to making any adjustments to the designated common area.
- 2. Alcoholic beverages sold for consumption in the designated common area shall be dispensed only in a container that clearly identifies the licensed premises from which the beverage was purchased. The amount of alcoholic beverage dispensed into this container shall not exceed sixteen (16) ounces.
- 3. A customer is not allowed to possess or consume more than one alcoholic beverage at a time while in the designated common area.

- 4. Alcoholic beverages may only be possessed or consumed within the designated common area during the hours in which the alcoholic beverage may be sold under G.S. 18B-1004. It is unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am and unlawful to consume alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:30 am and 7:00 am. On Sundays, it is unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:00 am and 12:00 noon, unless a city or county has elected to allow Sunday sales beginning at 10:00 am.
- 5. The owner or the property owners' association of the multi-tenant establishment may further limit the days and times in which alcoholic beverages may be consumed in the designated common area. Signs shall be posted in conspicuous locations in the multi-tenant property indicating the days and times alcohol may be consumed in the designated common area.
- 6. A customer in the designated common area shall dispose of any alcoholic beverage in his or her possession prior to exiting the common area unless the customer is entering an ABC licensed premises which allows a customer to enter with the alcoholic beverage.
- 7. A customer is not allowed to bring and/or consume alcoholic beverages in the designated common area not purchased from a tenant of the multi-tenant establishment holding the applicable permit.
- 8. Additional conditions may be imposed by the ABC Commission and may be found on the Commission's website.
- WHO MUST FILE AN APPLICATION Each individual required to file an application based upon the requirements for
 each type of ownership must complete the application, provide a completed fingerprint card (there is a \$38.00
 additional processing fee for each fingerprint card submitted), a completed Authority for Release form, and a black
 and white copy of their valid photo ID.
 - 1. **Individual Ownership** The individual owner of the business is required to file an application.
 - 2. **General Partnership** Each partner is required to file a separate application.
 - 3. **Corporation Not Holding** a permit in North Carolina Stockholders owning a 25% or greater interest and each officer (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer) must file separate applications. (Note: Articles of Incorporation must be submitted, including documentation to support ownership as outlined above.)
 - 4. **Corporation Currently Holding** a permit in North Carolina and are applying for an additional location Only one officer or the manager is required to file an application.
 - 5. Limited Liability Corporation (LLC) Not Holding a permit in North Carolina If Member-Managed, all members owning a 25% or greater interest must file an application; or, if no one owns 25% interest, the managing member(s) must file an application. If Manager-Managed, the person or persons acting as manager(s) on behalf of the LLC must file an application; additionally, any member who owns a 25% or greater interest in the company must also file an application. (NOTE: Articles of Organization must be submitted, including documentation to support ownership as outlined above. If Manager-Managed, a copy of the Operating Agreement must also be submitted.)
 - 6. **Limited Liability Corporation (LLC) Currently Holding** a permit in North Carolina and are applying for a permit at an additional location Only one officer/member or the site manager is required to file an application.
 - 7. **Limited Partnership** The general partner is required to file an application.
 - 8. **Manager/Site Manager** A North Carolina resident must submit an application as the manager/site manager of the establishment. If none of the above-referenced applicants will fulfill this role, an additional application, fingerprint card, Authority for Release and identification must be submitted.
- THE APPLICATION FEE FOR THE COMMON AREA ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT IS \$750.00. The renewal fee is \$750.00 each year.
