**NORTH CAROLINA ABC COMMISSION HOLDS REGULAR MEETING**

RALEIGH – The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Commission held its regular monthly meeting by conference call on May 12, 2021 and ratified 59 hearing cases that resulted in penalties in excess of \$69,600 and/or imposition of suspensions of permits for three days or more. Fines are due on or before June 4, 2021, and suspensions begin June 11, 2021.

The ABC Commission office building will undergo a roof repair project beginning in June, which will limit the number of individuals onsite. Also beginning in June, ABC permit applicants can schedule onsite appointments with ABC staff. Instructions will be made available on the ABC Commission public website.

The Commission declined to lift the summary suspension of ABC permits for Fazal and Sons, Inc. T/A MLK Discount Mart.

The Commission approved an amendment to the exemption order for Craft Revolution, LLC; Bold Rock Partners, LP; et al.

The Commission approved a proposed ABC store location at 701 West Main Street, Burnsville, requested by the Burnsville ABC Board. The store will replace the board's current store at 683 West US Highway 19E Bypass, Burnsville.

The Commission approved a proposed ABC store location at 11870 University City Boulevard, Charlotte, requested by the Mecklenburg County ABC Board. This store will replace the board's current store located at 9749 University City Boulevard, Charlotte.

The Commission also approved August 11, 2021 as a future Commission meeting date.
