**NORTH CAROLINA ABC COMMISSION ISSUES SUMMARY
SUSPENSION OF ABC PERMITS AT FAYETTEVILLE BUSINESS**

RALEIGH – Following a shooting incident on July 18, 2020, Jamaican VibeZ in Fayetteville has had its ABC permits suspended. The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission suspended the permits on July 24 after reviewing the sworn statements of Fayetteville Police Department officers.

Jamaican VibeZ, at 195 Starpoint Drive, Suite F-G, Fayetteville, has held ABC permits since May 2014.

The summary suspension is immediate and is in effect until the case is heard by the Office of Administrative Hearings. The action is authorized under N.C. General Statute 150B-3(c), which states: "The proceedings shall be promptly commenced and determined."

This is the second summary suspension issued this year by the NC ABC Commission and is part of the Commission's ongoing focus on public health, safety and welfare.
